PRE-INSTALLATION

Tools Required



Materials Included

4 leg levelers

Materials Required

- 3 wood screws
- 1 2x4 beam cut to size





INSTALLATION

Step 1: Determine the ideal location of your new vanity.

Note: Check if the location has at least two studs. Front notch the studs and install a 2x4 horizontal beam. This will add stability for the vanity.

Step 2: Attach the vanity to the wall with wood screws into the horizontal beam.



Step 3: Verify the vanity is level.

Adjust the leg levelers if needed.

See Figure 1.


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ADJUST DOOR HINGE

Side to Side

Locate the screw nearest the hinge cup and rotate clockwise or counterclockwise to move the door from side to side.

See Figure 2.



Front to Back

Locate the screw furthest away from the hinge cup and turn the screw clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the door from front to back.

See Figure 3.

Top to Bottom

Locate the screw pictured in Figure 6. Turn the screw clockwise or counterclockwise to move the door from top to bottom.

See Figure 4.

NOTE: When adjusting the door hinges keep in mind to adjust the other hinges.


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

DISMANTLE THE HINGE

Step1: There is a small button/lever on the back of the hinge (see Figure 6)Press it and lift up. The hinge should come free easily. Repeat for both hinges.






REMOVE CENTER DRAWER

Step1: Using a short Philips-head screwdriver, remove the four screws (two on each side)that attach the folding metal arms to the drawer face.

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Step2: When the folding metal arms are detached, fold the drawer all the way down.

Step3: Reach behind the drawer to release the hinges.

See "DISMANTLE THE HINGE" (Figure 5 and Figure 6)





Step4: Pull the drawer straight out to remove

NOTE:For plumbing, we recommend: - Using a bottle trap to avoid anypossible clearance issues - Installing wall bend and hot/cold

valves prior to installing the top

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
Step2: With the hinges re-attached, screw the folding metal arms back to the drawer face. Ensure that the "elbows" of the arms bend down, not up.

REMOVE DRAWER

Step 1: Pull the release latches located underneath the drawer.



Step 2: Slide and lift up the drawer box.



REINSTALL DRAWER

Step 1: Slide drawer box in until secured by rail hook.

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INSTALL THE VANITY TOP

- **Step 1:** Clean the surface of the cabinet with a damp cloth.
- **Step 2:** Install the sink to the vanity top per the manufacturer's instructions.
- **Step 3:** Apply a thin bead of silicone to the surface of the vanity.


Carefully place the vanity top on the vanity.

Clean off any excess silicone immediately.

Step 4: Follow the directions on the silicone tube to allow for ample drying time.

Refrain from moving/using the vanity during this time.



NOTE: For WideAppeal[™] Countertops:

WideAppeal[™] Countertops include a wooden inner frame. To prep the countertop for installation, first apply a thin bead of silicone to the inner frame, then attach the frame to the countertop.


Please note: a 1/2'' gap between the vanity top and the vanity is an intentional part of the design and is not a defect.

REINSTALL CENTER DRAWER

Step1: When the plumbing is finished, clip the hinges back on. There are small hooks on the bottom of the hinge (see below, left) that catch on the plate attached to the vanity. Align these, then press down on the back of the hinges until you hear a click.
