


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT

Before assembling your access lighting fixture, please make sure that you carefully read through these instruction sheets. Consider having your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrician.

NOTE: The important safeguards and instructions that appear in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care, are factors that can't be built into any product. These factors must be supplied by the person(s) caring for and operating the fixture.




GENERAL INFORMATION

All electrical connections must be in accordance with all ordinances, Local and National Electrical Codes. These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard $4" \times 2 \ 1/2"$ metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L. Recognized.

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting your installation disconnect the Power by turning off the Circuit Breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.



MOUNT CROSSBAR

If there is an existing fixture remove it. Expose the supply wires from the j-box. Mount the supplied crossbar to the J-Box.



CONNECT THE WIRES

Gently pull the supply wires. Connect the black fixture wire to the black supply wire and the white fixture wire to the white supply wire.


Connect the fixture ground wire to the J-Box ground wire. Secure all connections with the supplied wire caps. Tuck all wires carefully into the J-Box.

MOUNT THE CEILING PAN

Insert the supplied long screws into the holes on the crossbar. Align the keyholes on the ceiling pan then secure the ceiling pan flush against the ceiling.


INSERT THE BULB

Max 13w bulb.

DO NOT EXCEED THE RECOMMENEDED WATTAGE
AS STATED ON THE WARNING LABEL AND
INSTRUCTION SHEET.



ATTACH THE GLASS SHADE

Put the neck of the glass shade in place by inserting dimples located in the fixture, revolve the glass shade until tight fit
