Towel bar post is a die cast from the highest quality zinc alloy (Zamac). Casting is plated in chrome, brushed nickel or oil rubbed bronze. **Towel bar** is aluminum for brushed nickel and chrome finishes and brass for oil rubbed bronze.

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Determine desired length of towel bar.
- Fold mounting template to match desired length predetermined in step 1. Make sure horizontal lines on template matches after folding.
- 3. Position the mounting template on the wall in the desired location.
- 4. Using a level, align the template and tape it to the wall.
- 5. Drill two 5/16" holes at each mounting post location that corresponds to your product.
- 6. Remove the template from the wall.
- 7. Fold ends of the plastic toggle together and insert into each hole in the wall.
- 8. Lightly tap anchors until flush with the wall.
- 9. One at a time, insert plastic pin into each of the anchors and lightly tap to activate anchor. Remove pin and repeat on all anchors.
- 10. Remove mounting posts from the product assemblies by loosening each setscrew.
- 11. Place the mounting plate on the wall over the installed wall anchors with "UP" facing you.
- 12. Insert screws through the mounting plate into the anchors. Tighten the screws.
- 13. Assemble the towel bar and posts.
- 14. While assembled, position each end post with setscrews facing down and place over both mounting posts. Tighten the setscrew at the bottom of each post.

Cleaning Instructions:

To preserve the fine finish of this product, clean only with a soft damp cloth. Dry well. Do not use commercial or abrasive cleaners.
