

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This model is treated with DreamLine's exclusive ClearMax™ Glass technology. This is a specially formulated coating that prevents the buildup of soap and water spots.

Install the surface with the ClearMax[™] label towards the inside of the shower. Please note that depending on the model, the glass may be coated on either one or both surfaces.

For best results, squeegee the glass after each use and dry with a soft cloth.




These instructions will show the installation of the shower door. Please follow the same steps for the installation of the tub door.




This product should be installed by someone familiar with the construction requirements for this type of project and the care necessary for the safe installation and operation of the product.


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NOTE: The **right-hand door** installation is shown as an example throughout this manual. For the **left-hand door** installation, simply begin on the opposite wall and reverse the orientation of the parts in the steps shown.





Preparation

1. Prior to installation, examine all boxes and packages for shipping damage and compare the piece count with the packing slip. After opening all boxes and packages read this introduction carefully. Check that all of the necessary parts are included in the package by checking off the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Shower Door Components". If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or has missing parts, please contact our customer support department within **3 business days** of the delivery date. **Please note that DreamLine® will not replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 3 business days or if the product has been installed.** Contact DreamLine® if you have any questions, and please provide an order number, job name or other proof of purchase to help identify the original order.

2. Please note that you should consult your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine[®] is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.

3. If this unit is going to be installed in a new construction, please install all of the required plumbing and drainage before installing the shower. Use a competent and licensed (if required by local code) plumber for all plumbing installation

4. Please make sure that prior to beginning the installation, the surfaces are leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right angles. Irregular installation surface level, radius corners or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Note that some adjustments and drilling will be necessary during the installation process.

5. Please protect all primary surfaces of the product during installation. Never set the glass down directly onto a tile floor. Leave corner protectors in place until necessary to remove them. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard to protect the bottom edge and corners of the glass prior to and during installation.

6. This unit must be installed upon a finished threshold and against finished walls.

7. The panel side can be adjusted up to 1/4" within the u-channel for an out-of-plumb wall. The u-channel on the door side can accommodate up to 1/4" for an out-of-plumb wall. Use a level to verify that finished wall conditions are within this tolerance before installation.

8. This model requires that you drill into the threshold for proper installation.

9. Installation of the Guide Rail brackets into a stud or 2" x 6" wood reinforcement is strongly recommended. See Steps #8 and #19 for details.

10. This model requires a minumum of **2-1/4**" of flat threshold space for installation.


11. Professional installation required.

NOTE: This manual will describe the shower door installation. Please follow the same sequence of installation steps for the tub door installation.




NOTE: <u>DO NOT</u> attach the handle to the door glass until instructed.

DO NOT use the handle to lift the glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious injury. Always use an assistant and/or a professional grade glass suction cup when handling heavy glass panels.



NOTE: Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay it out and identify all parts using the detailed diagram and packing list in this manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that may have fallen to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine[®] for replacement. The shipping boxes may contain extra parts not used in your model configuration.




Installation steps













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10. Make sure the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)** is parallel to the front edge of the threshold and mark the position of the glass on the threshold (This line will be different from the line drawn in step#3). Slide the **Guide Block (#12)** into the notch of the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)**, and align it flush and square with the edge of the glass. Mark its position on the threshold and also mark the hole for drilling using a pencil (or center punch). **(Fig 10)**



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11. Remove the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)** from the **U-Channel (For Panel Glass) (#01)** and carefully set it aside. **(Fig 11)**

12. To install the **Guide Block (#12):** Loosen the set screw on the side and remove the **guide block face plate. (Fig 12.1)** Apply silicone to the underside of the **Guide Block (#12)** and screw the **Guide Block (#12)** to the threshold as described below:

*NOTE:

For installation into an Acrylic threshold:


drill an Ø1/8"(3mm) hole and use the ST4.0 x 25 Pan
Head Screw (#18)

OR


For installation into a Tile threshold:**


• drill a Ø3/16" (4mm) hole up to the stud and use the ST4.0 x 40 Pan Head Screw (#17). (Fig 12)

NOTE: For **Tub** installations: the bottom bracket must be screwed down to the tub deck.




Part#12 - Guide Block (with caps)






15. Align the panel end of the **Guide Rail (#04)** with the installed **Guide Rail Wall Bracket (#6b).** Slide the **Guide Rail Bracket (#06a)** over the **Guide Rail Wall Bracket (#06b)** and tighten the set screws. **(Fig 15)**







TIP: Leave the set screws that hold the **Guide Rail (#04)** to the **Guide Rail Bracket (#06)** loose for now to allow for side-to-side adjustment of the guide rail to make it easier to align the holes in the guide rail with the holes in the panel glass. **Tighten these set screws after the holes are aligned and the glass brackets are installed.**

16. Attach the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)** to the **Guide Rail (#04)** using the **Glass Brackets (#07)**. (Fig 16)






19. Remove the **Guide Rail (#04)** from the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)**. Remove the **Guide Rail Bracket (#06)** from the **Guide Rail (#04)** from the door end, hold it back in position on the wall and mark the anchor hole. Drill a Ø5/16" hole. Separate the **Guide Rail Bracket (#06)** components **(06a and 06b)**. Attach the **Guide Rail Wall Bracket (#06b)** to the wall using one **ST4.2 x 55 Countersunk Screw (#21)**. **(Fig 19)**



20. Re-attach the Guide Rail (#04) to the Stationary Panel Glass (#02) and attach the Guide Rail Brackets (#06). (Fig 20)

NOTE: Be careful not to scratch the upper rail while sliding the brackets onto the guide rail.



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





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


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


26. Attach the lower **Rollers (#08)** onto the **Door Glass (#03)** just below the **Guide Rail (#04)** with the wheels facing out. Apply **Thread Lock (#20)** to the roller bolts. Rotate the roller adjustment disk to raise these lower wheels tight to the **Guide Rail (#04)** and **tighten the bolts. (Fig 26)**





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27. To install the **SafeStop™ Bumper (#26) with the 3M tape:** Remove the **3M Tape** backing and position the **SafeStop™ Bumper (#26)** onto the threshold against the **U-Channel (#01)** on the stationary panel side of the installation. (Fig 27)



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29. Hold the **U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27)** against the wall on the door side of the opening to align it with the door glass and mark its position on the wall.


**Partially insert two of the SafeClose™ Bumper Inserts (#28) at the top and bottom and close the door into the U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27).

Mark the position of the **U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27)** on the wall along the outside edge. Open the door, hold the **U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27)** in place on the wall and mark the holes for drilling.

Remove the U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27) and the SafeClose™ Bumper Inserts (#28). Drill Ø5/16″ anchor holes and insert the Wall Anchors (#16).


Apply a bead of silicone to the wall or to the back of the **U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27).** Install the **U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27)** to the wall using the **ST4.0 x 40mm Pan Head Screw (#17).**

Use a 1/4" thick wooden or plastic shim to fully press the **SafeClose™ Bumper Inserts (#28)** into the smaller holes in **the U-Channel (For Door Glass) (#27). (Fig 29)**




TIP: Cover the shower/tub drain before removing the set screws to prevent loss.

30. Remove the set screws from the **panel-side Stopper (#05)** and apply **Thread Lock Adhesive (#20)** to each set screw. Re-insert the set screws into the stopper. Open the door and position the stopper where the door glass makes contact with the **SafeStop™ Bumper (#26)** at the bottom. Tighten the set screws firmly to the **Guide Rail (#04)**. Repeat the same steps for the door-side **Stopper (#05)**, positioning it to make contact with the **Roller (#08)** when the door is seated into the **SafeClose™ Bumper Inserts (#28)**. Once the **Thread Lock Adhesive (#20)** is applied to the set screws, reinsert them into the **Stopper (#05)** and tighten firmly to the **Guide Rail (#04)**. **(Fig 30)**



31. Attach the **Handle (#15)** to the outside of the **Door Glass (#03)** Make sure all gaskets are in place.

Attach the **Anti-Water Strips (#13)** to the edges of the **Stationary Panel Glass (#02)** and **Door Glass (#03)** where they overlap. **(Fig 31)**



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Product Maintenance

<u>BASES and BACKWALLS</u>: To ensure long-lasting life for your acrylic back walls, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could scratch or dull the surface.

<u>GLASS</u>: To ensure long-lasting life for your glass shower products, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface.

<u>HARDWARE</u>: To ensure a long-lasting finish, wipe off the metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft cloth. Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with (not across) the grain. Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.


NOTE: To maximize the life of your door, it is important to regularly inspect the glass and all hardware for misalignment, proper attachment, and/or damage. Contact DreamLine[®] with any questions or concerns.

DreamLine[®] shower doors and enclosures are designed not to leak when installed properly and the flow of water is not pointed directly at the vinyl seals.

Enigma-Sky Maintenance Checklist

□ Guide rail level and tight

- Guide rail brackets tight to the walls o All set screws tight
- □ Inline Panel glass secure
- D Panel glass brackets tight
- □ **Guide block** square to the threshold and glass
- □ Proper clearance beneath the door glass: between the threshold and within the guide block
- Door Glass adjusted so that the door closes firmly into the bumper inserts in the u-channel
- □ Wheel assemblies tight
 - o Wheel roller bolts tight
- □ **Stoppers** tight and positioned correctly
 - o Panel-side stopper set screws tight and secured to the guide rail
 - o Adequate Handle clearance when the door is fully open
 - o Door-side stopper positioned correctly and set screws are tight
- □ SafeStop[™] bumper secured to the wall and threshold
- □ Remove the vinyl seals to **inspect the edges of the door glass** for concealed damage
 - o Damaged glass must be replaced!
- □ Replace damaged or missing vinyl seals
