Installation Guidelines

IMPORTANT:

- > To ensure this product is installed properly, you must read and follow these guidelines.
- \triangleright The owner/user of this product must keep this information for future reference.
- > Be sure your installation conforms to all applicable codes.
- > This product must be installed by a professional contractor.
- Refer to the specifications and assembly drawings attached.
- > Inspect this product to assure it is the correct model and that you have all parts required for proper installation.
- > Take all necessary precautions to ensure the tub is protected during installation.

SHOWER ROD INSTALLATION:

- 1. Install the mounting plates (8) at the desired location using the screws (7) and anchors (9) provided. Drill 3/16" holes in drywall or ¼" in tile.
- 2. Slide the escutcheon (6) and mounting adapter (2) over each mounting plate and tighten the set screw (4).
- 3. Cut the shower rod (1) length to 1/16'' less than the distance between the adapters. Remove the burrs from the cut end of the rod.
- 4. Slide the O-ring end of the collar (3) over the rod until the rod protrudes slightly from the other end of the collar.
- 5. Position the rod (1) and collar (3) between the adapters (2) then thread the collars down until they contact the escutcheon (6).
