INSTALLATION FOR BIDET SETS

Note:

- Use teflon tape or pipe sealant for threaded connections.
- Do not use plumber's putty, chemical cleaners, or any product with ammonia on any of the brass components. This will cause the finish to tarnish and void the warranty. A non-corrosive 100% silicone is recommended.
- 1 Carefully remove all parts from the box. Identify which installation fits your bidet set.
 - Refer to installation diagrams No.1 or 2. See reverse side for installation diagram 3.

2 Install integral spray to bidet.

• Drop the spray head through the appropriate hole in the bowl of the bidet. From underneath, install the rubber washer, then the metal washer, then the nut. Tighten firmly.

3 Identify your hot and cold valves.

- Remove all trim from valve assembly, leaving bottom lock nut and one washer.
- Begin to tighten valve to bidet with the escutcheon, but do not tighten completely.
- Install handle on valve body. Be sure that bottom of handle properly clears top of the escutcheon.
- Once you have adjusted the valve height, remove handle and proceed to tighten valve from the bottom until it is snug.
- Install handle onto valve.

4 Install valve body.

- Remove trim from diverter valve body.
- Install 90° elbow into threaded side outlet. Ensure that the arrow stamped on the 90° elbow is facing outward (away from valve).
- Thread "Y" to bottom of valve. Ensure that fiber washer is in place inside the "Y".
- Remove the inverted nut, nylon slip rings and one self seating china seal from valve body. Slide valve body up through the center hole of the bidet and re-install the china seal, nylon slip ring, and inverted nut. Hand tighten until it is snug.

5 Place pop-up rod and knob through the appropriate guide holes.

6 Install hose connections.

For 4 hole bidet (diagram 1):

- Connect long hose to 90° elbow on diverter valve outlet to spray.
- Connect short hoses from "Y" on bottom of diverter valve to hot and cold valve.

For 3 hole bidet (diagram 2):

- Connect long hose to bottom of diverter valve.
- Connect rigid supply tubes to hot and cold valves.
- Thread on double check valves to bottom of hot and cold valves. These act as your vacuum breaker. When asked by inspector, refer to these items.

7 Install bidet valve trim.

- Thread escutcheon tube onto escutcheon.
- Thread the escutcheon nut onto inverted nut.
- Slide handle onto valve broach and tighten with supplied screw.
- Install handle cap with arrow facing towards front of bidet.

8 Begin bleeding the water lines before connecting to the valves. Connect water supplies to bottom of each valve.

9 Install pop-up assembly.


- Remove collar, plug, and tail piece from the pop-up body.
- Lower nut to the lowest possible thread.
- Push pop-up body, including washers up through the bidet drain.
- Screw collar to the pop-up assembly. You may want to use a sealant under the collar. Use a non-corrosive 100% silicone. The use of any other sealant will cause your warranty to be voided.
- Hand tighten the bottom nut. Do not over-tighten or you may crack your bidet.
- Re-attach the tail piece. This piece may have to be cut down depending upon the height of your drain.
- Unscrew side nut from pop-up assembly.
- Place ball washer inside hole.
- Place pop-up plug into the bidet, down through pop-up collar.
- Install ball rod into pop-up body.
- Place second ball washer on the rod. (Continued next page)

Install pop-up assembly (continued from previous page).

- Hand tighten side nut securely.
- Use thumb nut to secure rod extension onto end of lift rod.
- Pull ball rod towards nearest hole in lift rod extension. Lift rod extension may be bent to accomplish this.
- Secure the ball rod and lift rod extension with clip as shown in diagram.

10 Connect your P-trap to the drain tailpiece.

11 Check for leaks. If leaks or problems occur, re-tighten all nuts before consulting a plumber.

For installation diagram 3.

1 Carefully remove all parts from the box.

2 Install bidet valve.

- Install threaded brass nipple into bottom of bidet body.
- Place flat rubber washer under bidet body.
- Install flex lines below bidet body. Do not over-tighten or you may crack your bidet.
- Insert bidet body through hole of bidet.
- Place o-ring inside horseshoe retaining washer and place over threaded brass nipple and secure with brass nut.
- 3 Install pop-up assembly (see #9 above).
- 4 Connect your P-trap to the drain tailpiece.
- 5 Check for leaks. If leaks or problems occur, re-tighten all nuts before consulting a plumber.
