1. Connect the pedestal to the wall.

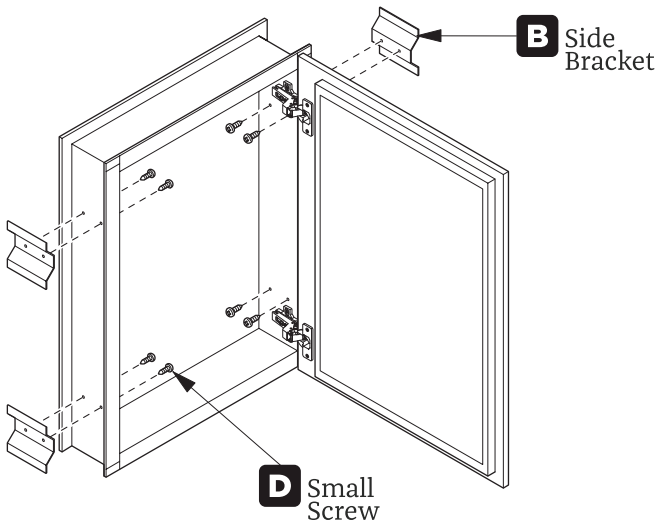

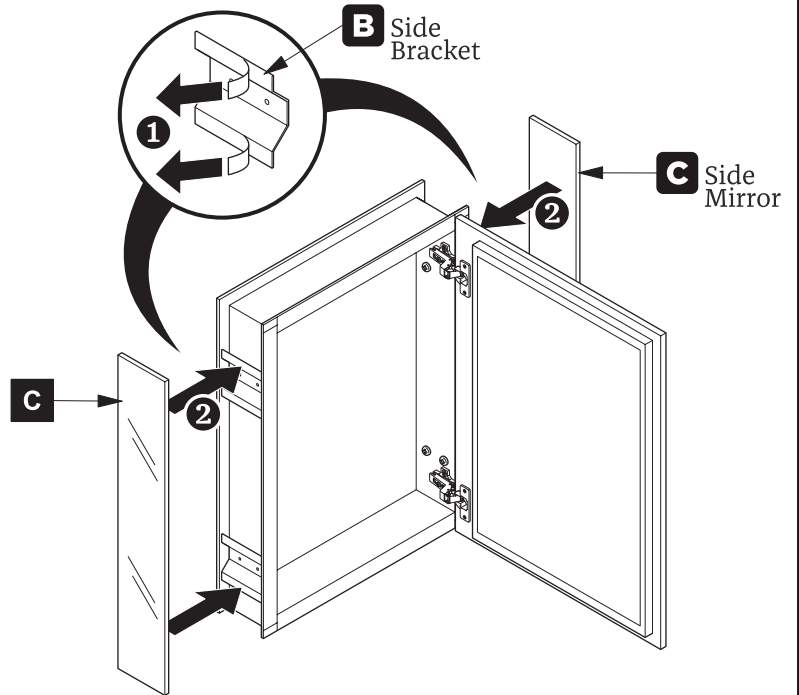

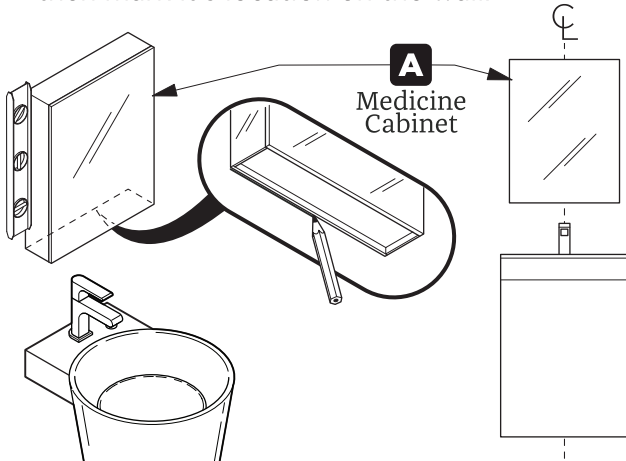
- 1.** Attach the brackets (B) to the cabinet's body using a small screws (D).



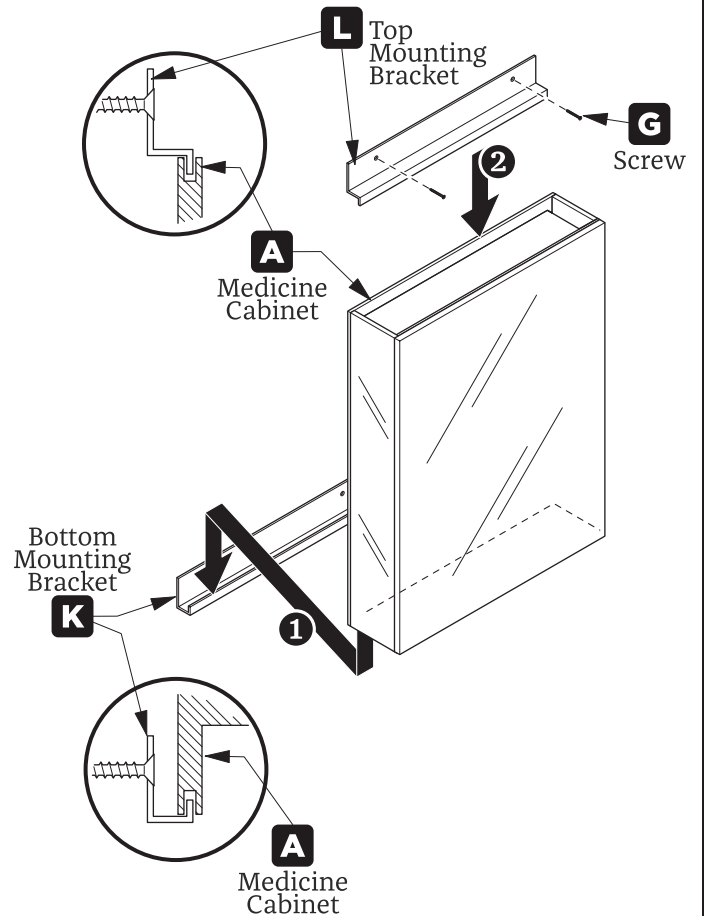
- 2.** Peel the tape from the brackets, exposing a sticky surface, then connect side mirrors (C) to the brackets (B).



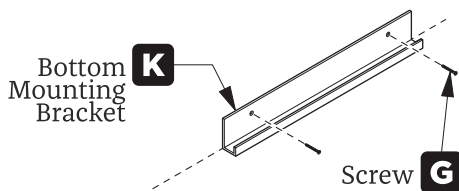
- 3.** Place cabinet (A) to designated location, then mark its location on the wall.



- 4.** With assistance, rest the cabinet on the bottom mounting bracket (K) and secure it by attaching a top bracket (L) to the wall.

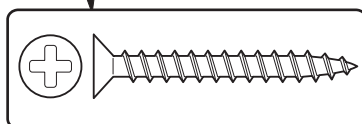


- 4.** Attach bottom bracket (K) to the wall.

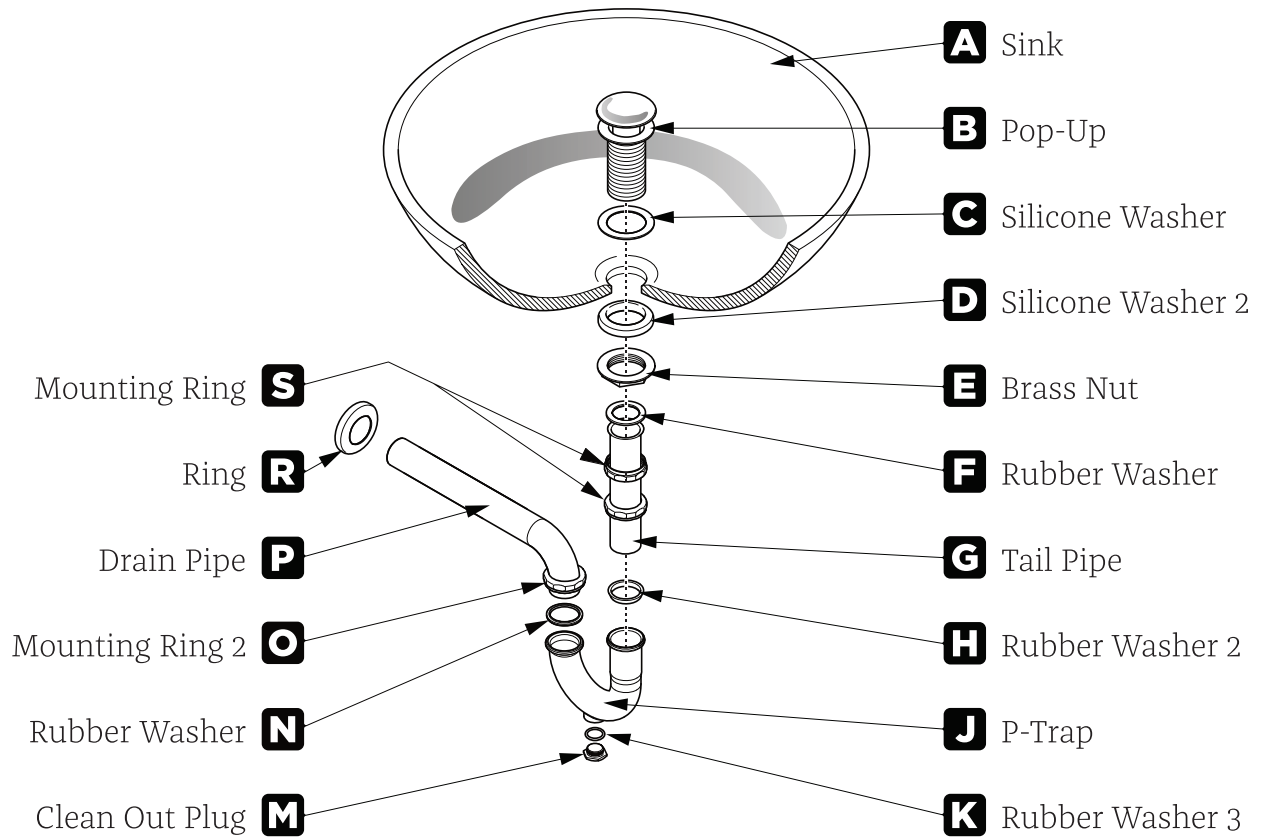

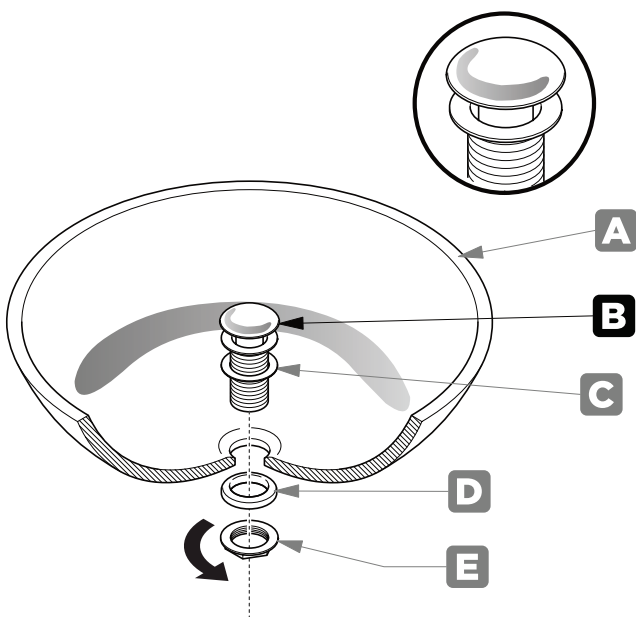

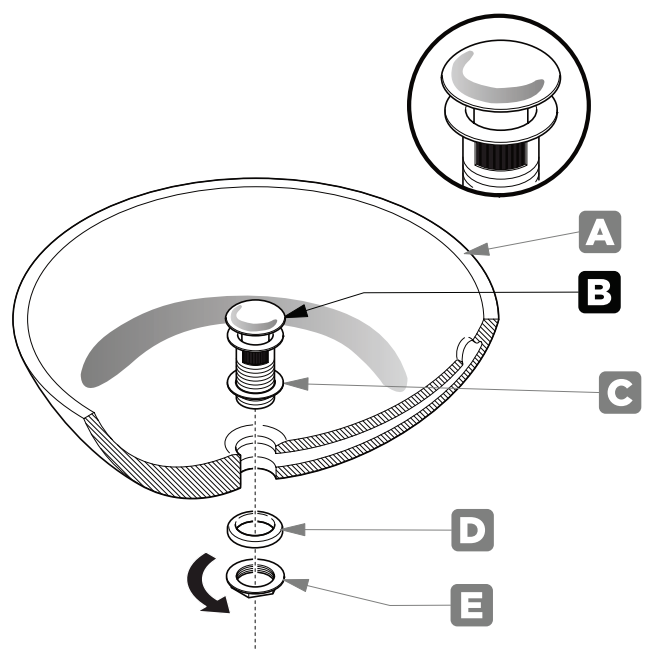

FOR SINKS WITHOUT OVERFLOW



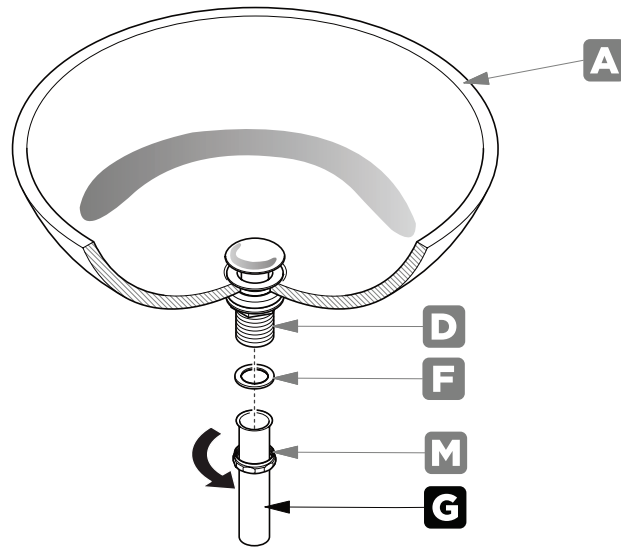

P-TRAP INSTALLATION

1. Install tail pipe (G).



2. Install P-trap (J).
